SITE INFORMATION

- \$45.00 each (Site only)
- All stall sites are outside, the size fits a standard 3 x 3 metre gazebo.
- Stallholders must provide their own tables, chairs, gazebos, tablecloths, display, etc, and anything else they need for their stall.
- No parking is allowed on the grass.
- All sites will be marked in squares indicated by chalk markings on the grass, with site numbers pegged in front and centre of the stalls.
- The market site is in a park; there are trees, hard and soft ground, and gardens. While we do our best to stay true to the map, there may be some variance on the day.

Please note: The market is smoke-free and no pets are allowed on site (except registered service dogs).

SET UP AND PACK DOWN:

Sites can be set up from 7am onwards and must be set up and ready by 9am at the latest. The event ends at 2pm and no earlier; sites must stay set up until this time, even if all stock is sold.

CANCELLATIONS:

We are weather dependent, as this is an outdoor market please make your own wet weather preparations . In the case of severe weather conditions a decision to cancel will be made by The Arts Village team, and will be posted on our social media and websites by 3pm on the 18th of September. We will email all stallholders, and a sign notifying the cancellation will be put up at The Arts Village front door.

Due to the costs associated with this event, there is a No refund policy for cancelation.
